



## DESIGN SERVICES

We like to work closely with our clients on the creation of their new garden. Here is an outline of how our landscaping process works.

### 1. Site analysis

We meet you to discuss your requirements and preferences:

- Do you want your garden to be dog/pet friendly?
- Do you want it to be a play area for your children?
- Do you use the outdoor space a lot or are you away from home often and require a low maintenance garden?
- Would you like to grow your own food or herbs?
- What colours do you like, and so on.
- It's your garden and we like you to be involved in the design process, so that together we create something that is just right for you and your family.

After this we analyse the character and physical appearance of the site. Is there any existing vegetation that needs to be kept? How is the slope of the site, prevailing wind direction and shade/full sun areas. We also take into consideration the views from the house and privacy issues.

### 2. Design presentation

Once we have drawn up an initial design proposal we present our ideas and concept to you. This consists of a design plan, planting plan, 3D renderings, quotation or bill of quantities. We discuss all the ideas and smaller details that may be changed such as finishes or sizes of materials. We also provide a program or schedule of works to give you a timeframe.

### 3. Detail drawing and construction

Once you accept our quote and give us the go ahead, we go into the detail phase where technical drawings are made for construction elements such as the outdoor shower. These drawings will include all the finishes and materials required. Once these are completed and approved, we start the construction and landscaping, followed by planting up of your dream garden.

### Client Summary








